It is that time of year to remind our school families about our Inclement Weather Closing and 2 Hour Delay policy. In the event of inclement weather, Mr. Adams will send a phone message through our One Call System and accurate information will be available through local radio and television stations. If it is announced that WADSWORTH CITY SCHOOLS are

closed or delayed, Sacred Heart will also be closed or delayed. A reminder that if we have a delay, Morning Care, Morning Pre-K and 1/2 day Kindergarten will be cancelled. If you are a NON Wadsworth resident, and your district cancels school and Wadsworth does not, we obviously encourage the attendance of your son/daughter but will not penalize him/her for the absence if you cannot get them to school. New Student Referral Program

We recognize that our current school families are often our biggest cheerleaders. Thank you to everyone that submitted referrals this year. Because of your efforts, we provided numerous tours and welcomed many new students. Those referrals that qualified will receive their tuition credit on the next statement. If you have any questions, please call Mary Gegick. The New Student Referral Program will continue for current Sacred Heart parents or guardians who are paying tuition for enrolled students (Kindergarten—through 8th grade). We will award a \$250 tuition credit to a current Sacred Heart family for each new student that is referred to, enrolls and attends Sacred Heart School. (Refer a family that enrolls two students and receive a \$500 credit, three students and receive a \$750 credit, etc.) To be eligible for the New Student Referral Program, you must first fill out a Referral Program form BEFORE the family calls, inquires, tours and registers for school. Forms are available in the school office, or on our school website. Thank you for your ongoing support of Sacred Heart of Jesus School.
