2020-2021 Registration

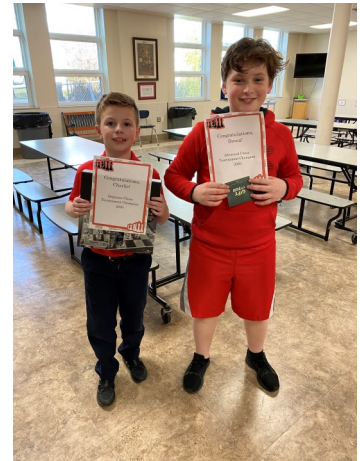
This Friday, March 13, Pre K and Kindergarten Registration packets are due. TAP (Tuition assistant program) applications are also due by this Friday.
